**2013 Albariño \$20** – Rugged, Earthy, and “green”, this light-bodied wine manages to compliment a wide range of food from shellfish to spicy, Indian fare.

**2012 Cloudland White \$15** – A blend of our estate-grown Chardonnay, Vidal Blanc, and Traminette with a splash of Viognier. A round and floral opening is followed by a clean and steely finish.

**2014 Chardonoga \$18** – A two-grape blend of Chardonal and Cayuga White, this crisp wine exhibits strong minerality with lingering notes of stone fruit and green apple.

**2010 California Chardonnay \$15** – Although these grapes hail from sunny California, this wine is not your typical California Chardonnay. Following more of the traditional European wine-making technique for Chardonnay, we have produced a light, un-oaked American version of a classic wine.

**2010 Oregon Riesling \$20** – The grapes used for this 2010 vintage produced an unexpectedly off-dry, very crisp and refreshing white wine. It is the epitome of an Oregon Riesling.

*dry rosé*

**2013 Southside Blush \$20** – This fully red-grape rosé is predominantly Cabernet Franc grown on our North Georgia Vineyard. This full palette of ripe berry notes finishes surprisingly cleanly.

*dry red*

**Labyrinth (NV) \$27** – A reserve red blend of premium, vinifera grapes from our local vineyards, barreled in French and American oak for fourteen months. Ripe, red fruits lead to a dark, chocolate finish.

**2009 Washington Syrah \$28** – The quintessential Syrah from a great vintage in Washington, this medium-bodied red wine was aged for 18 months in French Oak barrels. Hints of dried, dark fruits are supported with strong oaky and tannic structure.

*semi-sweet*

**2013 Chattaboogie Blanc \$18** – A sweet blend of Traminette, Viognier, and Riesling. This white wine delivers a full bouquet of floral and fruit notes.

**2012 Ridge Runner \$19** - This mid-sweet red wine, a blend of Norton, Cabernet Franc, Chambourcin, and Merlot has been sweetened to 3% residual sugar to compliment a fascinating nose of spices such as clove and nutmeg.

**2014 Strawberry \$18** – The freshest strawberries from the south, lovingly prepared and hand-crafted to preserve the fruity bouquet and crisp taste, with moderate residual sugar.

**2014 Mead \$19** – A traditional sweet mead made from wildflower honey from the Tennessee Valley. Crisp and refreshing with the essence of honey captured in the bottle.
